The suspect is a black male, approximately 6'-0" to 6'-3", thin build. He was last seen wearing dark pants and shoes, a long-sleeved white shirt under a dark colored short sleeve shirt. He was also wearing a winter ski mask hat, dark in color with white stripes. The weapon was a long barreled type weapon.
