Type of Incident: Recovered Stolen Property

Complaint # 13- 9347

On August 11, 2013, Pittsfield Township Police were notified by the Washtenaw County Sheriff's Department of a recovered handgun that was stolen on July 24th 2013 in Pittsfield Township. One person was in custody.

Type of Incident: Larceny From An Automobile/Possession Of A Controlled Substance/ Credit Card Fraud / Assist other agency

Complaint # 13- 9416

On August 12th 2013 at 4:57pm, while on patrol Pittsfield Township Police stopped a vehicle on Carpenter Road that fit the description of a vehicle involved in a stolen purse incident out of Ypsilanti Township. The driver matched the description, was stopped, and taken into custody. The suspect was in possession of multiple purses, credit cards and narcotics.

Type of Incident: Home Invasion / Suspicious Incident

Complaint # 13- 9427

On August 12th 2013 at 9:21pm, Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 4500 block of Meadowview Court for a reported home invasion. The victim reported someone had stolen a flat screen television from her home. There was no sign of forced entry. No other items were taken.

Type of Incident: Malicious Destruction Of Property

Complaint # 13- 9441

On August 13th 2013 at 9:30am, Pittsfield Township Police took a report at the station from a representative of the Washtenaw County Road Commission who reported someone attempted to pry open the door to a traffic control panel box located at Lohr and Lohr Circle. The incident occurred sometime between August 9th and 11th 2013, at 1pm. The estimated damage \$2,000.00.

Type of Incident: Attempted Motorcycle Theft

Complaint # 13- 9493

On August 14th 2013 at 12:51pm, Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 5200 block of West Michigan Avenue for a report of damage to a 2013 Harley Davidson Motorcycle. The seat was damaged and the battery cable cut.

Type of Incident: Strong Arm Robbery

Complaint # 13- 9531

Information: On August 15th 2013 at 3:30am, Pittsfield Police responded to the 3500 block of Ellsworth Road for a report of a strong arm robbery. Police made contact with two 17 year old males. One male was a resident of Ypsilanti and the other a resident of Ypsilanti Township. The two victims explained they were riding their bicycles eastbound on Ellsworth Road when a westbound pickup truck crossed over into the eastbound lanes, blocking the victims. The pickup truck stopped, three suspects got out of the truck and surrounded the two bicyclists. One suspect demanded both victims give up their bicycles. Both victims surrendered their bicycles. The suspects then put the bikes into the back of the pickup truck and drove off. The victims were unable to obtain details that would help identify the truck. Neither victim was harmed during the incident.

Suspects(s): Described as three white males. All suspects in their early 20's, two being approximately 5'7" tall and the other approximately 5'10". The suspects were in an older dark blue or black pickup truck. The truck may have been a Ford Ranger.

Type of Incident: Larceny From A Motor Vehicle

Complaint # 13- 9590

On August 16th 2013 at 8:59am, Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 3700 block of Palisades Blvd. for a report of a larceny from an unlocked 2011 Hyundai Sonata. The victim reported someone had stolen an I-Pod and a wallet containing \$200.00 in cash.

Type of Incident: Larceny

Complaint # 13- 9598

On August 16th 2103 at 1:15pm, Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 6600 block of Castaway Lane for a report of a person on a resident's property stealing hay. Three persons were identified as not having authorization to remove hay from her property. Estimated total loss over a two year period is \$5,000 to \$10,000.00.
