Identity Theft and Fraud Alert: The FDIC warns of a new threat of fake E-mails offering assistance from "ACH Security". The Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation issued this alert about an attack that claims retail and commercial accounts have been suspended because of suspected ACH and wire fraud. The email contains an attachment called "*FDIC document .zip*" which the FDIC warns will likely unleash malware to be installed on the recipients' computer. U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission - Recall on Gel Fuels: Nine Manufacturers, Distributors Announce Consumer Recall of Pourable Gel Fuel Due to Burn and Flash Fire Hazards

Sept.1, 2011, The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC), in cooperation with nine manufacturers and distributors, announced a voluntary recall of all pourable gel fuels made or sold by these companies. Due to the serious risks of flash fire and burns when consumers add pourable gel to an already burning fire pot, consumers should immediately stop using the pourable gel fuel.

The recall involves an estimated 2 million units of various pourable gel fuels packaged in one-quart plastic bottles and one-gallon plastic jugs and sold in scented and non-scented formulations, which were sold since 2008 for between \$5 and \$20 by the companies listed below.
