The Pittsfield Township Police Department responded to the scene of a Hit & Run crash on 9/5/12 at 11:30pm, at the above location. A witness spoke to the driver on scene before he left the area on foot, prior to police arrival. Family members have not heard from the driver since before the crash and have reported him as a missing person.

September 8, 2012

Type of Incident: Missing Person (Nathan Tracy)

Date: 9/8/12 Time: 10:38 a.m.

On the morning of Saturday, September 8, 2012 at approximately 10:38 a.m., a maintenance worker from Weatherstone Condominiums, (Oak Valley Drive at Weatherstone Drive), found the deceased body of a male subject believed to be that of missing person, Nathan Tracy.

The body was found in a retention pond located near the entrance of the Weatherstone complex. The Pittsfield Township Police Department was immediately called and officers responded to recover the body and investigate the scene. Although efforts to positively identify the body were unsuccessful, at this time it is believed to be Nathan Tracy. Methods to positively identify the deceased are ongoing. Cause of death is unavailable at this time pending an autopsy scheduled to take place on Sunday, September 9, 2012. Family has been notified.
