Fire Prevention Tip

Gree Electric Appliances recalls 12 brands of dehumidifiers due to serious fire and burn hazards. More than \$2 million in property damage reported.

The Consumer Product Safety Commission reports the dehumidifiers can overheat, smoke and catch fire. The dehumidifiers were manufactured by Gree Electric Appliances and carried the brand names of Danby, De'Longhi, Fedders, Fellini, Frigidaire, Gree, Kenmore, Norpole, Premiere, Seabreeze, SoleusAir and SuperClima.

They were sold nationwide at major retailers including Home Depot, Kmart and Lowe's between January 2005 and August of this year.

Consumers should immediately turn off and unplug the dehumidifiers and contact Gree at (866) 853-2802 for a refund. Click on the image below for more details on the recall.
