Pittsfield Township's Department of Public Safety will participate in the D.E.A.'s "National Prescription Drug Take Back Day" on **Saturday, October 29, 2011, from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm** at 6227 W. Michigan Ave, Ann Arbor, MI 48108 to provide a venue for persons who want to dispose of unwanted and unused prescription drugs in "pill form" only.

National Prescription Drug Take Back Day addresses a vital public safety and public health issue. More than seven million Americans currently abuse prescription drugs, according to the 2009 Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration's National Survey on Drug Use and Health. Each day, approximately, 2,500 teens use prescription drugs to get high for the first time according to the Partnership for a Drug Free America. Studies show that a majority of abused prescription drugs are obtained from family and friends, including the home medicine cabinet.

Significant Criminal Events:

Armed Robbery 2011-9759

On September 19, 2011 at approximately 12:26 am, Pittsfield Township Police Officers were dispatched to the 2100 Block of Glencoe Hills Dr. for an Armed Robbery complaint. The victim advised that while walking through the parking lot of the complex three black males armed with long guns approached him and one told him to give them his money. The victim reached into his pockets and pulled out his wallet, containing an undisclosed amount of currency and his cellular telephone. The suspects took the items then ran from the location towards the Arbor Point Apartments.

The complainant described the three black males as wearing dark clothing, one with a red ball cap and all armed with long guns. After obtaining a description of the suspects three individuals were detained nearby in the Arbor Point Complex. The suspects were interviewed and released pending further investigation. This is an ongoing investigation and anyone with information pertaining to this case is requested to contact the department.
