Weekly Public Safety Activity Summary October 11-17th, 2010

COMMUNITY EVENTS/INFORMATION

On October 18, 2010 with the assistance of the community, the Pittsfield Township Department of Public Safety identified the vehicle and subjects that were involved with last week's reported suspicious vehicle following the school buses. The subjects are two teenagers, one residing in the area of the incidents and the other in the Saline community.

On October 12, 2010 a report of a suspicious incident was reported to the department. In that incident it was reported that a subject in a white conversion van with a raised roof had opened the passenger door as a young child walked past. The child's mother was close by, observing this and concerned for the child's safety called to the child at which time the van drove away. There were two other incidents identified involving the van and children on that day. One of the incidents involved the van following a child on a bicycle and in another the passenger in the van yelled out the window at a child as he/she went past.

Both subjects as well as their parents have been contacted by the department and the behavior has been addressed. The passenger of the vehicle advised that his intent was only to scare the kids. The Pittsfield Department of Public Safety would like to thank the community in assisting and identifying the vehicle involved and bringing a potentially dangerous incident to a close.

Larceny From Motor Vehicle's: # 2010-10657

On October 16, 2010 at approximately 1:55 pm, an officer was dispatched to the 2100 block of Oak Valley Drive for a report of a larceny from a motor vehicle. The officer identified four vehicles that had been entered with two of them having something stolen. Further investigation revealed that at 2:18 am on that date a dark

colored Jeep Wrangler style vehicle with a soft top entered the parking lot and parked near the victim's vehicles. Three subjects were observed walking in the area of the victims vehicles and within three minutes they drove out of the parking lot. The victims were away on a trip and returned later that morning and discovered the incidents. Stolen were an iPod and a GPS unit. The department is in the process of obtaining the surveillance video in an attempt to obtain a description of the suspects.
