Pittsfield Township's Department of Public Safety will participate in the D.E.A.'s "National Prescription Drug Take Back Day" on **Saturday, October 29, 2011, from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm** at 6227 W. Michigan Ave, Ann Arbor, MI 48108 to provide a venue for persons who want to dispose of unwanted and unused prescription drugs in "pill form" only.

National Prescription Drug Take Back Day addresses a vital public safety and public health issue. More than seven million Americans currently abuse prescription drugs, according to the 2009 Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration's National Survey on Drug Use and Health. Each day, approximately, 2,500 teens use prescription drugs to get high for the first time according to the Partnership for a Drug Free America. Studies show that a majority of abused prescription drugs are obtained from family and friends, including the home medicine cabinet.

Robbery Armed: 2011-11051

On October 20, 2011 at approximately 9:46 pm, the Pittsfield Township Police Department received a 911 call regarding two men, one of them armed, and entering an apartment in the 3000 block of Woodland Hills Drive. Officers responded to the location and were able to make contact with the victims of the apartment through a window. The victims were assisted out of the apartment due to not knowing if the suspects were still in the apartment. Once the victims were secure with an officer the additional officers searched the apartment and discovered the suspects had already fled.

The victims, a 13 and 14 year old males, stated that the suspects knocked on their door indicating they were a neighbor. Once the victim opened the door the suspects forced their way into the apartment pointing the gun at the victims while directing them to get into the bathroom.

The suspects were described as early twenty year old black males, both approximately 5'-8" tall with one of them having a bandana over his face. The gun was described as a silver revolver type. The suspects stole an undisclosed amount of cash from the apartment.
