Type of Incident: Assault with Intent to Murder

Complaint # 13- 13038

Information: On October 29th 2013, at 1:15am, Pittsfield Police responded to a report of a stabbing at a residence in the 2500 block of Torrey in the Oak Park subdivision. Upon arrival police found a 51 year old male suffering from several stab wounds. A 52 year old female was arrested at the scene. Both the victim and the suspect are residents of Pittsfield Township. This incident was determined to be domestic related and police are not looking for other suspects. The victim was treated on scene by the Pittsfield Township Fire Department and Huron Valley Ambulance personnel. He was then transported to an area hospital for non-life threatening injuries. The suspect was also transported to an area hospital for evaluation. Following treatment she was expected to be lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail.

Arrested: 52 year old female resident of Pittsfield Township

Injuries: Non-life threatening stab wounds
