

**Federal Trade Commission: Stolen Checks**

If an identity thief steals your paper checks, uses the account number from the bottom of your checks, or opens a new account in your name, contact your bank or financial institution as soon as possible and ask them to close your account.

Federal law doesn't limit your loss if a thief forges your signature on your checks or uses your account number to buy something by phone. Most states hold banks responsible for losses from those fraudulent transactions. For their part, banks expect you to take reasonable care of your accounts. That means you might be responsible for a loss if you know there's a problem, but you don't report it to your bank quickly.

### **Type of Incident: Breaking and Entering**

Complaint # 14-3464

Information: On March 20, 2014, at 2:06 a.m., Pittsfield Township Police responded to the Target store at 2000 Waters Rd. for a Breaking and Entering. Upon arrival the store was searched and no suspects were found inside. The suspects removed glass panels from two front doors to gain entry and stole multiple high priced electronics from the store. The suspects activities were recorded on store cameras and they fled the scene in a tan or silver sedan.

**SUSPECT(S):** 4 unknown suspects wearing dark clothing and face masks. The suspects are all average build between 5'1" and 5'5".

### **Type of Incident: Breaking and Entering**

Complaint # 14-3554

Information: On March 22, 2014, at 4:14 a.m., The Pittsfield Township police responded to the Target store, located at 3749 Carpenter Road, for a report of an attempted breaking and entering. The suspects fled the scene prior to police arrival and went to the Target store located in Canton where they broke into the store. The suspect vehicle fled the scene when Canton police arrived at the location. The suspect vehicle fled into Ypsilanti where the chase ended and two (2) of the four (4) occupants of the vehicle were taken into custody by Ypsilanti officers. One suspect is a 17-year-old resident of Ypsilanti and the second suspect is an 18-year-old Pittsfield Township resident. The suspects are believed to be the same subjects that broke into the Target store located at 2000 Waters Road in Pittsfield Township on March 22, 2014.

**Arrested:** 17-year-old resident of Ypsilanti and an 18-year-old resident of Pittsfield Township.

### **Type of Incident: Stolen Vehicle**

On March 22, 2014, at 2:45 p.m., Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 4400 block of Hunt Club Dr. for a report of a stolen 2009 Pontiac G3 from a garage.

**Type of Incident: Breaking and Entering**

Information: On March 23, 2014, at approximately 9:29 p.m., Pittsfield Police officers responded to the 4800 Block of Washtenaw Avenue. A business owner reported that he was called by his alarm company regarding an alarm trip. The owner responded and found that his business had been broken into. Officers responded to the scene and determined that the suspects had also broken into a business next door by damaging and breaking through a wall that separated the businesses. An undisclosed amount of money was stolen from both businesses. The suspects fled in an unknown direction. Ann Arbor Police K9 assisted in an area search.
