**Fire Incident: Mutual Aid**

On June 30, 2014, at 7:20 p.m., Pittsfield Township Fire personnel assisted Ann Arbor Township Fire Department with putting out a house fire in the 4200 block of Shetland Dr.

**Fire Incident: Wires Down**

On July 1, 2014, at 3:22 a.m., Pittsfield Township Fire personnel responded to the 2800 block of Oakdale Dr. for arching wires.

**Fire Incident: Wires Down**

On July 1, 2014, at 8:53 a.m., Pittsfield Township Fire personnel responded to the 2500 block of Deake Ave. for a transformer explosion.

**Fire Incident: Motor Vehicle Accident**

Complaint # 14-1465

On July 3, 2014, at 4:09 p.m. the Pittsfield Township Fire Department was dispatched to a reported rollover accident on Southbound US23 at Michigan Ave. Arriving units found a car and a pick-up truck with extensive damage. Hydraulic tools (Jaws of Life) were used to remove the driver's door of the pick-up truck. Two patients were transported to the hospital one critical and one serious. There were also two fatalities at the scene. M.S.P. is conducting the investigation.

**Fire Incident: Motor Vehicle Accident**

Complaint # 14-1468

On July 3, 2014, at 9:16 p.m., the Pittsfield Township Fire Department was dispatched to a reported motor vehicle accident on Southbound US 23 just North of Ellsworth Rd. Arriving units found a car that had collided with an SUV, both with extensive damage. The patient of the car was transported to U of M with critical injuries. The SUV had three patients in serious and stable condition that were also transported to the hospital.

**Fire Incident: Structure Fire**

Complaint # 14-1475

Information: On July 4, 2014, at 9:46pm the Pittsfield Township Fire Department responded to the 4700 block of Sandstone Pass for multiple 9-1-1 calls reporting a fire in The Pines of Cloverlane Apartment Complex. Residents reported seeing a large fire on the balcony and hearing smoke detectors alarming inside the building.

Upon arrival firefighters were confronted with heavy fire coming from a third floor apartment and extending into the back.

Firefighters performed a search of the building and found that all occupants had safely evacuated the building. An aggressive interior attack was initiated utilizing 3 hose lines to fight the blaze. Firefighters battled the fire for 45 minutes in order to bring it under control.

The fire was contained to two apartments and the attic space above them. The other ten apartments suffered minor smoke and water damage but no fire damage. The fire appears to be accidentally caused by an unattended barbeque grill located on a 3rd floor balcony. However, the official cause of the fire is still under investigation by the Pittsfield Township Fire Marshall.

The Pittsfield Township Fire Department was assisted on-scene by the Ann Arbor City Fire Department, Ypsilanti City Fire Department, Ypsilanti Township Fire Department and Superior Township Fire Department.
