Although Labor Day often signals the end of summer, parents and caregivers must continue to be diligent and never leave children alone in vehicles. So far this year, **13** children have died from heatstroke while unattended in vehicles in states all across the country.

**Together, we can reduce the number of heatstroke deaths and near misses by remembering to ACT.**

**A**void heatstroke-related injury and death by never leaving your child alone in a car, not even for a minute. And make sure to keep your car locked when you're not in it so kids don't get in on their own.

**C**reate reminders by putting something on the backseat of your car next to your child such as a briefcase, a purse or a cell phone that is needed at your final destination. This is especially important if you're not following your normal routine.

**T**ake action. If you see a child alone in a car, call **9-1-1**. Emergency personnel want you to call. They are trained to respond to these situations. One call could save a life.
