On September 11, 2013, at 11:19 p.m. Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 4400 block of Hunt Club Dr. for a report of an attempted robbery of a pizza delivery driver.

On September 12, 2014, at 12:24 a.m., Pittsfield Township police responded to a report of an armed robbery of a pizza delivery driver at the Motel 6 on S. State Street. The victim was robbed of an undisclosed amount of cash, pizza, and delivery bag. The suspect fled the area to the west and is believed to have left in a vehicle. Canton Township Police K-9 assisted with an area search with negative results. The suspects involved fit the description of the attempted armed robbery on September 11, 2014, incident # 14-11640.

******UPDATE****** On September 13, 2014, the Pittsfield Township Police Department along with the Ann Arbor Police Department and the Washtenaw County Sheriff's Office worked together in the investigation of three armed robbery suspects as they continued their crime spree, targeting pizza delivery drivers. The suspects were taken into custody on September 13, 2014 by the Ann Arbor Police Department after a traffic stop was made on the suspect vehicle. The suspects have been identified as Corey Michael Duncan, 18 years of age and a resident of Ypsilanti Township, and Kyle Anthony Cryer, also 18 years of age and a resident of Ann Arbor. The third suspect is a juvenile. All suspects remain in custody. Corey Duncan and Kyle Cryer were arraigned today and are currently being held at the Washtenaw County Jail

Type of Incident: Attempted Home Invasion

Complaint # 14-11682

On September 13, 2014, at 12:30 a.m. Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 1200 block of Bicentennial Pkwy. for a report of a possible Home Invasion in progress. A resident returned home and observed several teenagers at the front door, and it looked as if they were attempting to gain entry. They ran from the area; officers canvassed the neighborhood and park area but were not able to find the teens. They did not gain access to the home. The incident remains under investigation.
