Pittsfield Charter Township Awarded \$19,000 from the McCalla Trust Fund

Pittsfield Township (October 28, 2010) -- Pittsfield Charter Township has been awarded \$19,000 through the McCalla Trust Fund. The purpose of the trust is to distribute trust funds for the benefit of elderly persons and/or handicapped children in Washtenaw County. Awards from the Helen McCalla Trust must be used for permanent or semi-permanent buildings and/or equipment benefitting elderly persons and/or handicapped children.

“We pursued this grant in order to begin delivering on our promise to improve the facilities for our Senior Center. The intent is to use the grant money to repair the roof, replace ceiling tiles, paint the interior walls and renovate the north entry to make it more accessible,” announced Supervisor Mandy Grewal.

The Pittsfield Township Senior Center is part of the Parks & Recreation building at 701 W. Ellsworth. “The Senior Center is a vital part of the lives of over 1600 senior citizens from Pittsfield Township and its neighboring communities and we want to make sure that it continues to provide a cheerful gathering space for them. On behalf of our Seniors who frequent the Senior Center, I extend a big thank you to the Helen McCalla Trust for making these improvements possible,” Grewal remarked.
