Staples: Data Breach Reported December 19, 2014

Staples' data security experts detected that criminal's deployed malware to some point-of-sale systems at 115 of its more than 1,400 U.S. retail stores. Upon detection, Staples immediately took action to eradicate the malware in mid-September and to further enhance its security. Based on its investigation, Staples believes that malware may have allowed access to some transaction data at affected stores, including cardholder names, payment card numbers, expiration dates, and card verification codes. At 113 stores, the malware may have allowed access to this data for purchases made from August 10, 2014 through September 16, 2014. Overall, the company believes that approximately 1.16 million payment cards may have been affected. Specific stores and dates can be found by clicking the image below for more details.
