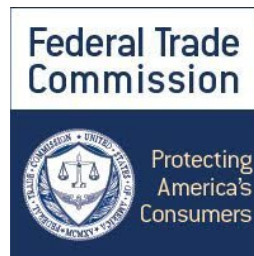

Police Incident: Breaking and Entering

Complaint # 14-15786

Information: On December 21, 2014, at approximately 1:37 a.m., Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 3700 block of Carpenter Rd. for a breaking and entering alarm. Officers responded to the scene and based on witness accounts determined that two black males had broken the front window to the store. An undisclosed amount of items were stolen from the business. The suspects fled from the scene in a red Dodge Charger.

Suspect(s): Two black males and one unknown suspect driving the suspect vehicle.

Police Incident: Armed Robbery suspect arrested

Complaint # 14-14660

Information: On November 22, 2014, at approximately 8:41 p.m., a Domino's Pizza delivery driver was called to a vacant residence located in the 5500 block of Amber Way in Pittsfield Township. Upon arriving to the residence he was assaulted with a hammer and robbed.

The Pittsfield Township Department of Public Safety's detective bureau conducted an in-depth investigation, leading to the identification of the suspects involved.

On December 23, 2014, a search was executed at a residence in the 4900 block of Sycamore Drive, Pittsfield Township. Suspect, Michael Burns Leath, 18-years-old, and resident of Ypsilanti Township, was present at this location and arrested.

Leath was lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail and arraigned on Count 1: Robbery - Armed - Serious Injury and Count 2: Robbery - Armed. A bond of \$250,000/cash bond was set. A second suspect was identified and charges are pending.

Injuries: The victim sustained serious injury to head and has recovered.

Arrested: Michael Burns Leath, 18-years-old
