On February 21, 2015, at 10:02 p.m., Pittsfield Township Police responded to the area of Golfside Rd. and Washtenaw Ave. for a reported armed robbery of a person . Victim stated she was exiting a business when an unknown subject asked her for some money. The victim stated that the suspect then struck her in the face with some type of blunt object that resembled a wooden club. The victim stated that the suspect attempted to strike her a second time as she tried to get into her vehicle but she was able to block the strike. The unknown suspect took the victim's wallet and fled the scene into a nearby apartment complex. A search of the area was conducted with negative results.

Suspect: Unknown black male approximately 5'9" stocky build in his late 30s with some facial hair last observed wearing a dark navy Carhart style jacket, black shoes, dark colored pants, and a dark navy stocking cap.
