Fire fighters arrived to find a working fire on the first floor of a two story townhome extending to the second floor and attic. The families exited the two story townhome on their own but were not able to find the family cat. Pittsfield Township Fire Fighters extinguished the fire and found the cat, uninjured. HVA evaluated the family members and Pittsfield Police Officers evacuated nearby townhomes. There were no injuries. Estimated damage \$60,000 to the building and contents.
