Police Incident: Armed Robbery

On February 1, 2016, at 10:49 p.m., Pittsfield Township Police were dispatched to the 3100 block of Ann Arbor Saline Rd., Meijer store for a report of a woman being robbed of her purse in the parking lot. Police determined that the victim, a 57 year old female resident of Pittsfield Twp., was loading groceries into her vehicle in the parking lot when she was approached by a lone suspect. The suspect displayed a handgun and ordered the victim to give him her purse. The victim surrendered her purse and the suspect then fled on foot. It was further determined that the suspect then fled in an unknown vehicle. The victim was not injured during the incident.

Suspect: Described as a younger white male, approximately 5'05" tall and skinny. No clothing description was reported.
