On April 4, 2016, at 1:15 p.m., Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 2100 block of Glencoe Hills Dr. for a reported Home Invasion. The door had been kicked in, nothing reported stolen.

**Police Incident: Home Invasion**  
**Complaint #16-3866**

On Monday, April 4, 2016, at approximately 12:18 p.m., Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 2500 block of Carpenter Rd. for an unoccupied home invasion. The door had been kicked in and the residence was gone through and jewelry stolen. Officers arrived on scene and located the two suspects near the location of the home invasion. Once the suspects saw the police, they failed to comply and ran. The suspects were apprehended a short time later and the stolen property that the suspects hid at a nearby hotel was recovered. The suspects were transported to the Washtenaw County Jail and held until arraignment on April 6, 2016.

Steven Joseph Miracle, 20 years-of-age and resident of Ypsilanti Township, along with Darius Devon Walker, 20 years-of-age and resident of Ypsilanti Township, were both charged with Felony Home Invasion - 2nd Degree and Felony Police Officer - Assaulting/Resisting/Obstructing. Both individuals were arraigned and given a bond amount of \$5,000/10%. Miracle and Walker are scheduled for a probable cause conference on April 19, 2016.
