INFORMATION: On March 21, 2017, the Pittsfield Township Department of Public Safety received a report of a 35-year-old male, and resident of Ypsilanti, had been shot in the 3000 block of Woodland Hills Drive. The incident occurred at approximately 9:30 PM. It was reported that two suspects were standing near a bus stop located on Packard Road. The victim was walking from an apartment building toward Packard Road when two (2) subjects, whose faces were concealed, approached him and attempted to rob him at gunpoint. The victim sustained a non-life threatening gunshot wound to the leg. Both suspects then fled on foot in an unknown direction.

The suspects are described as two (2) males, unknown race/ethnicity, between 16 – 25 years of age. Both of the suspect's faces were concealed.
