DTE Energy has notified the township of upcoming planned power outages in Washtenaw County, as they work to safely complete repairs to the electrical system. According to DTE Energy, they will be inspecting utility poles, replacing old cables, and replacing wooden cross arms with fiberglass ones.

Customers affected by the outages will receive a call from DTE Energy prior to the outage.

To prevent damage, please disconnect and leave unplugged any appliances, refrigerators, televisions, computers, and other sensitive electronics until after electric service is fully restored.

If you plan to use a portable generator, please have your installation checked by a licensed electrician. Never use a portable generator inside your home, as it emits carbon monoxide, which can be deadly. Keep it outside and away from windows and doors, so that fumes will not come inside your home.

The planned power outages in Washtenaw County have been scheduled for the following dates, times, and approximate areas.

**Ann Arbor** - in and around the area north of the Huron River near Plymouth Road. The outage is scheduled for Thursday, January 30 beginning at 9:30 AM, lasting about 30-45 minutes. Should inclement weather or some other factor cause a postponement, this interruption will be rescheduled for Friday, January 31 at 9:30 AM.

**Pittsfield Township** - in and around the area south of Interstate 94 near Ellsworth and Lohr roads. The outage is scheduled for Friday, January 31 beginning at 9:00 AM, lasting for about 45 minutes.
