Pedestrian Safety: Dalton and Packard Rd Crossing

Pittsfield Township Public Safety has requested a new pedestrian sign at the corner of Dayton Ave. and Packard. This sign is intended to provide better notification about walkers crossing Packard especially for our students and families who use this crossing in the morning and afternoon.

Soon you will see the sign below posted at this location. Additionally, the Washtenaw County Road Commission will be changing the crossing signal timing at the end of the school day. This will provide more time for our walkers to cross with the Crossing Guard on Packard.

If you drive this route please be aware of the need to yield to crossing pedestrians especially when turning right onto Packard.
