During regular business hours, (Monday-Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm) citizens will have access to non-contact services in the public safety lobby with the following restrictions:

- Please do not call for admittance if you have a fever, or if you (or anyone you’ve had contact with) have any flu-like symptoms.
- Face masks must be worn by anyone entering the lobby.
- If you need to conduct business with the Records Dept. or other non-contact functions coordinated by front desk personnel **during regular business hours**, please call **734-255-1653**.
- The outside callbox remains the best way to contact dispatch to speak with an officer or file a report, anytime day or night.
- Only one party will be allowed entrance into the lobby at a time.



The Census counts every person living in the United States once, only once, and in the right community.




CENSUS IS SAFE
