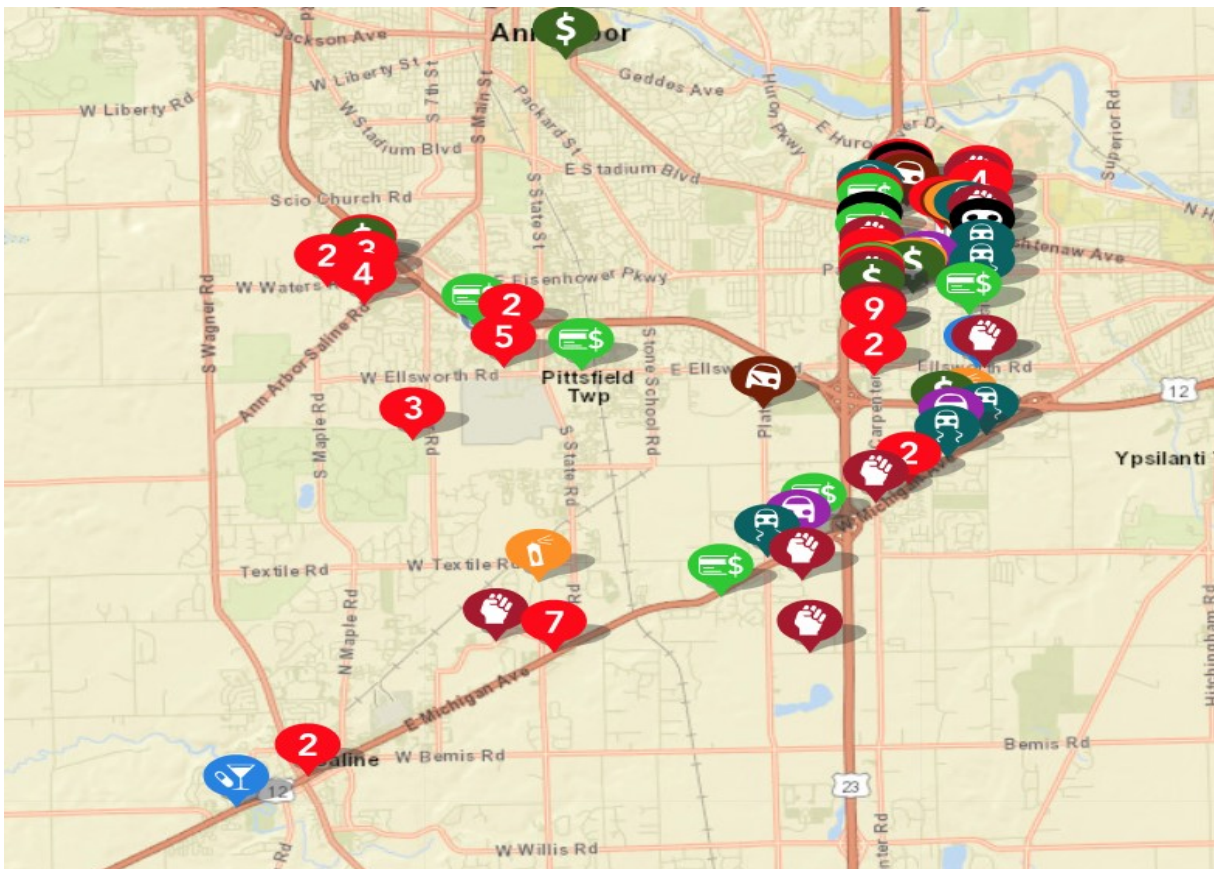

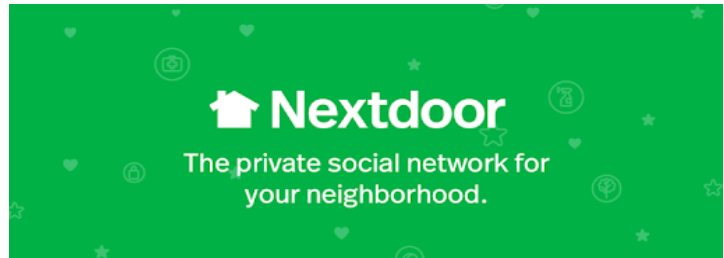
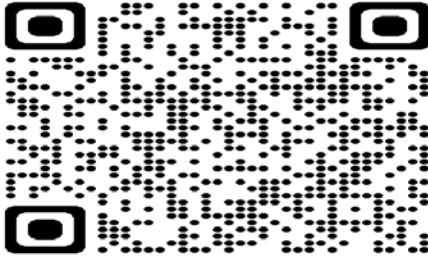

## Jeep Wrangler 4xe SUVs Are Recalled Due to Fire Risk

The automaker advises owners to park them away from buildings until fixed

Stellantis is recalling more than 32,000 [Jeep Wrangler](#) 4xe plug-in hybrid SUVs from the 2021-2024 model years due to a fire risk. No other Wrangler versions are included in this action. In a statement, the automaker says: “The vehicles may be driven. However, the company is advising owners to refrain from recharging these hybrid vehicles, and to park them away from structures and other vehicles, until they are remedied.”

Stellantis has identified eight fires with parked vehicles. In six of those cases, the Wrangler 4xe was connected to electric chargers.

The fix is a software update, and only 1 percent of the recalled group is estimated to have the problem.

Stellantis says it’s not aware of any crashes or injuries related to this defect.

The Details

**Vehicles recalled:** 2021-2024 [Jeep Wrangler](#) 4xe.

**The problem:** These plug-in hybrid SUVs are at risk of a fire when parked.

**The fix:** The remedy involves a software flash. If a certain error code is observed, the battery pack will be replaced.

**How to contact the manufacturer:** Owners may call Jeep at 800-853-1403.

**NHTSA campaign number:** 23V787.

**Check to see whether your vehicle has an open recall: [NHTSA’s website](#) will tell you whether your vehicle has any open recalls that need to be addressed.**

If you plug your car’s 17-digit vehicle identification number (VIN) into NHTSA’s website and a recall doesn’t appear, it means your vehicle doesn’t currently have one. Because automakers issue recalls often, and for many older vehicles, we recommend checking back regularly.
