

MARSH VIEW MEADOWS

300 East Textile Road

Marsh View Meadows Park is one of the township's newest parks. The Parks & Recreation Department was successful in being awarded a Michigan Department of Natural Resources Trust Fund Grant in 2003 to help develop the site. Construction began in the fall of 2005 and the park was completed at the end of 2006. This 54 acre park is located in the southwest portion of the Pittsfield Preserve at 300 East Textile Road. The park includes 2 miles of ADA accessible 8' wide nature trails, trail benches, 2 playground structures, 2 wildlife observation decks, a boardwalk through a sedge meadow, restroom facility, picnic pavilion, interpretive and directional signage, 50 car parking lot, large play field, and landscaping.




PARK SPOTLIGHT ~ MARSH VIEW MEADOWS
