The Washtenaw County Water Resources Commissioner will meet on the above date, time and location to receive construction bids for the Hickory Hollow Sub Drain. Bids will then be opened and publicly announced.

The Hickory Hollow Sub Drain will be let in 1 section as follows, each section having the length, average depth and width as set forth:

Construction of 223 feet of HDPE 24" storm piping at an average depth of 3.5' in replacement of existing clay tile and installation of two (2) 4' diameter storm structures. No culverts or bridges will be removed or replaced in conjunction with the bid.

This Notice of Letting, the plans, specifications and bid proposal shall be considered a part of the Contract. The Contract will be let in accordance with the Contract Documents now on file at Orchard, Hiltz & McCliment, Inc. and the Washtenaw County Water Resources Commissioner's Office and available to interested parties. A security deposit in the form of a cashier's check, money order, certified check or bidders bond shall be submitted with any bids. No cash will be permitted. The security deposits of all unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after the Contract is awarded.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder giving adequate security for the performance of the work and meeting all conditions represented in the Instructions to Bidders. The

Contract completion date and the terms of payment will be announced at the time and place of letting. If no satisfactory bids are received, we reserve the right to reject any and all bids and to adjourn to a time and location as we shall announce.

If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.
