Statistics for the current period are from August 1, 2020, through August 31, 2020. During that period, the Department of Public Safety saw the following activity:

Review of Notable Crime Activities August 1, 2020 – August 31, 2020

- Zero (0) Homicides occurred this August, as well as last August. YTD, homicides have decreased by 100% this year compared to the same time last year. (0 this year compared to 1 last year).
- Two (2) Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) offense occurred this August compared to one (1) last August showing an increase of 100%. YTD, CSC offenses have increased 33.33% (15 this year compared to 10 last year).
- Three (3) Robberies occurred this August compared to two (2) last August showing an increase of 50%. YTD, robberies have increased 42.86% this year compared to the same time last year (10 this year compared to 7 last year).
- Four (4) Aggravated Assaults occurred this August, as well as last August. YTD, aggravated assaults have decreased 16.13% this year compared to the same time last year (26 this year compared to 31 last year).

- One (1) Burglary – Residential occurred this August, as well as last August. YTD, residential burglaries have decreased 53.85% this year from the same time last year (12 this year compared to 26 last year).
- Three (3) Burglaries – All Other occurred this August, as well as last August. YTD, Burglaries – All Other have remained the same this year from the same time last year (13 this year compared to 13 last year).
- Thirteen (13) Larcenies occurred this August compared to nine (9) last August showing an increase of 44.44%. YTD, larcenies have decreased 21% this year compared to the same time last year (79 this year compared to 100 last year).
- Larcenies from Vehicles decreased 40% this August (15) compared to last August (25). YTD, larcenies from vehicles decreased 52.94% this year from last year (64 this year compared to 136 last year).
- Four (4) Motor Vehicle Thefts (MVT) occurred this August compared to fifteen (15) last August showing a decrease of 73.33%. YTD, MVT decreased 54.35% this year from last year (21 this year compared to 46 last year).
- Six (6) Malicious Damage of Property (MDOP) incidents occurred this August compared to nine (9) last August showing a decrease of 33.33%. YTD, MDOP offenses have decreased 1.61% this year from last year (61 this year compared to 62 last year).
- Drug/Narcotic violations decreased 7.69 this August (12) compared to last August (13). YTD, drug/narcotic violations decreased 28.8% this year from last year (89 this year compared to 125 last year).
- Seven (7) Operating under the Influence (OUI) arrests occurred this August compared to eight (8) last August showing a decrease of 12.5%. YTD, OUI arrests have decreased 7.84% this year from the same time last year (47 this year compared to 51 last year).
