### Review of Notable Crime Activities May 1, 2020 – May 31, 2020

- Zero Homicides occurred this May, as well as last May. YTD, homicides have remained the same. (0 this year compared to 0 last year).
- Two (2) Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) offenses occurred this May as well as last May. YTD, CSC offenses have increased 33.33% (8 this year compared to 6 last year).
- Two (2) Robberies occurred this May compared to one (1) last May showing an increase of 100%. YTD, robberies have increased 75% this year compared to the same time last year (7 this year compared to 4 last year).
- Five (5) Aggravated Assaults occurred this May compared to four (4) last May showing an increase of 25%. YTD, aggravated assaults have decreased 25% this year compared to the same time last year (15 this year compared to 20 last year).

- Zero (0) Burglaries – Residential occurred this May compared to six (6) last May showing a decrease of 100%. YTD, residential burglaries have decreased 60% this year from the same time last year (8 this year compared to 20 last year).
- One (1) Burglary – All Other occurred this May compared to 2 last May showing a decrease of 50%. YTD, Burglaries – All Other have remained the same this year from the same time last year (6 this year compared to 6 last year).
- Seven (7) Larcenies occurred this May compared to seventeen (17) last May showing a decrease of 58.82%. YTD, larcenies have decreased 32.81% this year compared to the same time last year (43 this year compared to 64 last year).
- Larcenies from Vehicles decreased 68% this May (8) compared to last May (25). YTD, larcenies from vehicles decreased 52.17% this year from last year (33 this year compared to 69 last year).
- Four (4) Motor Vehicle Thefts (MVT) occurred this May as well as last May. YTD, MVT decreased 35% this year from last year (13 this year compared to 20 last year).
- Eight (8) Malicious Damage of Property (MDOP) incidents occurred this May compared to sixteen (16) last May showing a decrease of 50%. YTD, MDOP offenses have decreased 2.78% this year from last year (35 this year compared to 36 last year).
- Drug/Narcotic violations increased 37.5% this May (22) compared to last May (16). YTD, drug/narcotic violations decreased 25.93% this year from last year (60 this year compared to 81 last year).
- Seven (7) Operating under the Influence (OUI) arrests occurred this May compared to twelve (12) last May showing a decrease of 41.67%. YTD, OUI arrests have increased 3.03% this year from the same time last year (34 this year compared to 33 last year).
