### Review of Notable Crime Activities October 1, 2020 – October 31, 2020

- Zero (0) Homicides occurred this October, as well as last October. YTD, homicides have decreased by 100% this year compared to the same time last year. (0 this year compared to 1 last year).
- Two (2) Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) offenses occurred this October compared to four (4) last October showing a decrease of 50%. YTD, CSC offenses have increased 5.26% (20 this year compared to 19 last year).
- Two (2) Robberies occurred this October compared to one (1) last October showing an increase of 100%. YTD, robberies have increased 33.33% this year compared to the same time last year (12 this year compared to 9 last year).
- Two (2) Aggravated Assaults occurred this October compared to one (1) last October showing an increase of 100%. YTD, aggravated assaults have increased 5.71% this year compared to the same time last year (37 this year compared to 35 last year).

- Four (4) Burglaries – Residential occurred this October compared to two (2) last October showing an increase of 100%. YTD, residential burglaries have decreased 48.49% this year from the same time last year (17 this year compared to 33 last year).
- Zero (0) Burglaries – All Other occurred this October compared to two (2) last October showing a decrease of 100%. YTD, Burglaries – All Other have decreased 5.88% this year compared to the same time last year (16 this year compared to 17 last year).
- Eighteen (18) Larcenies occurred this October compared to thirteen (13) last October showing an increase of 38.46%. YTD, larcenies have decreased 9.68% this year compared to the same time last year (112 this year compared to 124 last year).
- Larcenies from Vehicles decreased 61.9% this October (8) compared to last October (21). YTD, larcenies from vehicles decreased 56.82% this year from the same time last year (76 this year compared to 176 last year).
- Six (6) Motor Vehicle Thefts (MVT) occurred this October compared to three (3) last October showing an increase of 100%. YTD, MVT decreased 32.69% this year from the same time last year (35 this year compared to 52 last year).
- Six (6) Malicious Damage of Property (MDOP) incidents occurred this October compared to four (4) last September showing an increase of 50%. YTD, MDOP offenses have increased 2.74% this year compared to the same time last year (75 this year compared to 73 last year).
- Drug/Narcotic violations decreased 42.86% this October (12) compared to last October (21). YTD, drug/narcotic violations decreased 21.2% this year from the same time last year (119 this year compared to 157 last year).
- Four (4) Operating under the Influence (OUI) arrests occurred this October compared to eleven (11) last October showing a decrease of 63.64%. YTD, OUI arrests have decreased 27.78% this year from the same time last year (52 this year compared to 72 last year).
